HILO TOWER LETTER TO AIRMAN 04-1

SUBJECT: Practice Instrument Approaches

CANCELLATION: April 30, 2006

1. PURPOSE: This Letter to Airman advises pilots that IFR separation will be provided to VFR aircraft conducting practice approaches at the Hilo International Airport.
2. PROCEDURES:
 - a. VFR aircraft desiring practice instrument approaches IFR or VFR at the Hilo International Airport should contact Hilo Approach on the appropriate frequency as published in the Pacific Chart Supplement and Airport Directory and Flying Safety Manual.
 - b. Hilo Approach will issue clearance for VFR or IFR practice approach, advise of expected delays or refuse to authorize practice approaches as traffic conditions require.
