The new AC Form 3150-7 (4/98) is now out and should be used for application for Physiological Training at select United States Air Force bases. All previous editions are obsolete and should be discarded as the procedures for securing this training have been drastically changed. New procedures are:

1. To secure a class date and be enrolled the prospective student MUST CALL AIRMAN EDUCATION PROGRAMS at (405)954-4837. The student will be given class dates available at various USAF bases at this time.
2. Students who agree upon a date and base assignment that is available will be added to the base roster at this time.
3. The student will then be sent the AC Form 3150-7 (4/98), with the obligation that it be returned within the specified time along with the \$35 dollar fee.
4. Once the fee has been received by CAMI the student is locked in for the specified date and base of choice and the fee is non-refundable. Students who do not return the form within the specified time they will lose their assigned slot.
5. Students should not call the USAF bases for dates.

These new procedures were initiated to give students a firm date and base of choice at the time of inquiry. We also want to improve the show rates at the participating USAF bases.
